- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 2, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 6 amended by adding Article 2.022 to read as follows:
- 7 Art. 2.022. ASSISTANCE OF TEXAS RANGERS. (a) The attorney
- 8 representing the state may request the Texas Rangers division of
- 9 the Department of Public Safety to provide assistance to a local law
- 10 enforcement agency investigating an offense that:
- 11 (1) is alleged to have been committed by an elected
- 12 officer of the political subdivision served by the local law
- 13 enforcement agency; and
- 14 (2) on conviction or adjudication, would subject the
- 15 elected officer to registration as a sex offender under Chapter 62.
- 16 (b) For purposes of this article, "assistance" includes
- 17 investigative, technical, and administrative assistance.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
