- 5 SECTION 1. Section 609.5025, Government Code, is repealed.
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 609.007(c), Government Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (c) To [Except as provided by Section 609.5025, to]
- 9 participate in a deferred compensation plan, an employee must
- 10 consent in the contract to automatic payroll deductions in an
- 11 amount equal to the deferred amount.
- 12 SECTION 3. Section 659.102(a), Government Code, is amended
- 13 to read as follows:
- 14 (a) An employee of a state agency may authorize in writing a
- 15 deduction each pay period from the employee's salary or wage
- 16 payment for coverage of the employee under an eligible supplemental
- 17 optional benefits program. [A deduction may be made each pay period
- 18 from the employee's salary or wage payment without authorization in
- 19 writing from the employee for participation in a 401(k) plan as
- 20 provided by Section 609.5025.
- 21 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

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1 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
