5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 28.002, Education Code, is amended by

- 7 adding Subsection (c-1) to read as follows: (c-1) In cooperation with the State Board of Education and 8 9 with the participation of educators, the agency shall develop
- written materials that provide additional specific guidance 10 regarding the essential knowledge and skills identified in 11
- 12 accordance with Subsection (c). The materials must include
- appropriate clarifiers such as exemplar activities and qualifying 13
- 14 statements.

- SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 28, Education Code, is 15
- amended by adding Section 28.016 to read as follows: 16
- Sec. 28.016. CURRICULUM MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS. (a) In this 17
- section, "curriculum management system" means a comprehensive, 18
- fully integrated online computer-based system that: 19
- (1) links and aligns all teaching, learning, and 20
- 21 assessment components of student academic achievement; and
- 22 (2) may include components such as curriculum,
- 23 instructional resources, assessments, a data warehouse, and a
- reporting feature capable of being customized to meet specific 24

- 1 school district needs.
- 2 (b) As a resource for school districts, the agency shall:
- 3 (1) evaluate curriculum management systems available
- 4 in this state, including systems developed by school districts,
- 5 regional education service centers, and regional education service
- 6 center cooperatives; and
- 7 (2) compile a list of curriculum management systems
- 8 that conform to the essential knowledge and skills of the required
- 9 curriculum identified under Section 28.002.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
