- 2 relating to a study regarding the health and safety issues posed by
- 3 uncovered ditches that abut surface streets.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. (a) In this section, "department" means the
- 6 Department of State Health Services.
- 7 (b) The department shall conduct a study regarding the
- 8 health and safety issues that may arise from the presence of
- 9 uncovered ditches that abut surface streets.
- 10 (c) The study must:
- 11 (1) identify any health and safety concerns posed by
- 12 uncovered ditches that abut surface streets, including:
- 13 (A) the public health issues that may arise from
- 14 standing water accumulating in ditches; and
- 15 (B) traffic hazards that may be caused by the
- 16 ditches; and
- 17 (2) propose solutions to address any problems
- 18 identified.
- 19 (d) Not later than September 1, 2010, the department shall
- 20 submit to the governor, lieutenant governor, speaker of the house
- 21 of representatives, and presiding officers of the relevant standing
- 22 committees of the legislature with jurisdiction over the department
- 23 a written report containing the findings of the study and the
- 24 department's recommendations.

- 1 (e) This Act expires September 1, 2011.
- 2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
