- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 501, Government Code, is

- 8 Sec. 501.0165. IDENTIFICATION CERTIFICATE. (a) Not later
- 9 than the 90th day before the date an inmate is transferred to
- 10 pre-parole status, the department shall request a personal
- 11 identification certificate from the Department of Public Safety for
- 12 the inmate if the inmate does not possess a valid driver's license
- 13 <u>or personal identification certificate.</u>

The department must accept as satisfactory 10 proof of identity under this section an offender identification 11 card or similar form of identification issued to an inmate by the
- 12 <u>Texas Department of Criminal Justice.</u>
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
