- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 62.106(a), Government Code, is amended
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (a) A person qualified to serve as a petit juror may
- 7 establish an exemption from jury service if the person:
- 8 (1) is over 70 years of age;
- 9 (2) has legal custody of a child younger than 10 years
- 10 of age and the person's service on the jury requires leaving the
- 11 child without adequate supervision;
- 12 (3) is a student of a public or private secondary
- 13 school;
- 14 (4) is a person enrolled and in actual attendance at an
- 15 institution of higher education;
- 16 (5) is an officer or an employee of the senate, the
- 17 house of representatives, or any department, commission, board,
- 18 office, or other agency in the legislative branch of state
- 19 government and presents a letter from the lieutenant governor, a
- 20 member of the legislature, or the administrative head of a
- 21 legislative agency that states that jury service by the officer or
- 22 employee would cause an undue or extreme burden to the legislature;
- 23 (6) is summoned for service in a county with a
- 24 population of at least 200,000, unless that county uses a jury plan

- 1 under Section 62.011 and the period authorized under Section
- 2 62.011(b)(5) exceeds two years, and the person has served as a petit
- 3 juror in the county during the 24-month period preceding the date
- 4 the person is to appear for jury service;
- 5 (7) is the primary caretaker of a person who is an
- 6 invalid unable to care for himself;
- 7 (8) except as provided by Subsection (b), is summoned
- 8 for service in a county with a population of at least 250,000 and
- 9 the person has served as a petit juror in the county during the
- 10 three-year period preceding the date the person is to appear for
- 11 jury service; or
- 12 (9) is a member of the United States military forces
- 13 serving on active duty and deployed to a location away from the
- 14 person's home station and out of the person's county of residence.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to a person summoned to
- 16 appear for jury service who is required to appear on or after the
- 17 effective date of this Act. A person summoned to appear for jury
- 18 service who is required to appear before the effective date of this
- 19 Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before the
- 20 effective date of this Act, and the former law is continued in
- 21 effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
