## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the minimum number of county jailers necessary to staff
- 3 a county jail.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 351, Local Government
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 351.045 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 351.045. MINIMUM STAFF. (a) The sheriff or the
- 8 administrator of a county jail, as applicable, shall employ at
- 9 least one county jailer for every 48 inmates housed in the county
- 10 jail.
- 11 (b) The commissioners court of a county shall provide
- 12 sufficient funding for the employment of county jailers in the
- 13 <u>number required by this section.</u>
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 351.045, Local Government Code, as added
- 15 by this Act, applies to the commissioners court of a county and to
- 16 the sheriff or jail administrator of a county beginning on the first
- 17 day of the first county fiscal year that begins after the effective
- 18 date of this Act.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
