4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 2305.038, Government Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
7	(c) The comptroller, with the cooperation of the Texas
8	Education Agency, shall develop information designed to promote
9	awareness of the resources available under this section. The

- 10 comptroller and the agency shall distribute the information
- 11 annually to school district superintendents and energy management
- 12 staff through:
- 13 <u>(1) e-mail notifications;</u>
- 14 (2) printed materials; and
- 15 (3) information posted on the Internet websites
- 16 maintained by the comptroller and the agency.
- 17 SECTION 2. Subchapter F, Chapter 271, Local Government
- 18 Code, is amended by adding Section 271.1021 to read as follows:
- 19 <u>Sec. 271.1021. COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM DATABASE.</u>
- 20 (a) The comptroller shall establish and post on the comptroller's
- 21 Internet website a database of cooperative purchasing programs
- 22 <u>available to a school district. The database must include:</u>
- 23 (1) the membership requirements and membership fees of
- 24 each program;

- 1 (2) a description of the broad commodity and service
- 2 categories offered by each program; and
- 3 (3) a link to each program's Internet website.
- 4 (b) The comptroller shall consult with each local
- 5 government participating in a cooperative purchasing program
- 6 before including the program's information on the database
- 7 <u>established under Subsection (a).</u>
- 8 (c) The comptroller and the Texas Education Agency shall,
- 9 through e-mail, annually notify school district superintendents
- 10 and purchasing staff of the database established under Subsection
- 11 (a).
- 12 SECTION 3. Not later than January 1, 2010, the comptroller
- 13 of public accounts shall establish the database required by Section
- 14 271.1021, Local Government Code, as added by this Act.
- 15 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
