H.B. No. 2186

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT
2 relating to the payment of a vehicle registration fee by a check
3 drawn against insufficient funds.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 502.181(a), Transportation Code, is
6 amended to read as follows:

7 (a) A county assessor-collector who receives from any
8 person a check or draft drawn on a bank or trust company in payment
9 of a registration fee for a registration year that has not ended on
10 a motor vehicle, trailer, or motorcycle sidecar that is returned
11 unpaid because of insufficient funds or no funds in the bank or
12 trust company to the credit of the drawer of the check or draft
13 shall ~~[immediately]~~ certify the fact to the sheriff or a constable
14 or highway patrol officer in the county after attempts to contact
15 the person fail to result in the collection of payment. The
16 certification must:

- 17 (1) be under the assessor-collector's official seal;
- 18 (2) include the name and address of the person who gave
19 the assessor-collector the check or draft;
- 20 (3) include the license plate number and make of the
21 vehicle; ~~[and]~~
- 22 (4) be accompanied by the check or draft; and
- 23 (5) be accompanied by documentation of any attempt to
24 contact the person and collect payment.

1 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
2 to a payment of a registration fee submitted to a county
3 assessor-collector on or after the effective date of this Act. A
4 payment submitted before the effective date of this Act is governed
5 by the law in effect on the date the payment was submitted, and the
6 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
