| 24 | SECTION 3. Section 22.015, Penal Code, is repealed.               |

## H.B. No. 2187

SECTION 4. (a) The change in law made by this Act in 1 amending Section 71.022, Penal Code, applies only to an offense 2 committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An offense 3 committed before the effective date of this Act is covered by the 4 5 law in effect when the offense was committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, 6 an offense was committed before the effective date of this Act if 7 8 any element of the offense occurred before that date.

9 The repeal by this Act of Section 22.015, Penal Code, (b) does not apply to an offense committed under that section before the 10 effective date of the repeal. An offense committed before the 11 effective date of the repeal is covered by that section as it 12 existed on the date on which the offense was committed, and the 13 14 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of 15 this subsection, an offense is committed before the effective date of the repeal if any element of the offense occurs before that date. 16 17 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
