- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 434, Government Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 434.019 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 434.019. VETERANS HOSPITAL. (a) The Texas Veterans
- 9 Commission and the Department of State Health Services shall work
- 10 with the United States Department of Veterans Affairs and any other
- 11 appropriate federal agency to propose that the federal government
- 12 <u>establish a veterans hospital in the Rio Grande Valley region of the</u>
- 13 state.
- (b) The state may contribute money, property, and other
- 15 resources to the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a
- 16 veterans hospital described by this section.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
