- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 151, Tax Code, is amended
- by adding Section 151.334 to read as follows: 6
- 7 Sec. 151.334. SOLAR AND WIND ENERGY DEVICES. (a) In this
- section: 8
- (1) "Solar energy device" means a system or series of 9
- mechanisms designed primarily to provide heating or cooling or to 10
- produce electrical or mechanical power by collecting and 11
- 12 transferring solar-generated energy.
- 13 (2) "Wind energy device" means a system or a series of
- 14 mechanisms designed primarily to provide heating or cooling or to
- produce electrical or mechanical power by collecting and 15
- 16 transferring wind-generated energy.
- (b) The sale of a solar or wind energy device purchased for 17
- noncommercial home or personal use to which this section applies is 18
- exempted from the taxes imposed by this chapter if the sale takes 19
- place during a period beginning at 12:01 a.m. on the Saturday 20
- preceding the last Monday in May (Memorial Day) and ending at 11:59 21
- p.m. on the last Monday in May. 22
- 23 (c) The purchaser must give the seller an exemption
- certificate that certifies in writing to the seller that the solar 24

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- 1 or wind energy device qualifies as exempt under Subsection (b).
- 2 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act does not
- 3 affect tax liability accruing before the effective date of this
- 4 Act. That liability continues in effect as if this Act had not been
- 5 enacted, and the former law is continued in effect for the
- 6 collection of taxes due and for civil and criminal enforcement of
- 7 the liability for those taxes.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
