## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to possession by certain alcoholic beverage permit holders
- 3 of certain alcoholic beverages for cooking purposes.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 25.09, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 25.09. POSSESSION OF CERTAIN BEVERAGES PROHIBITED.
- 8 (a) Except as provided by this section, a [No] wine and beer
- 9 retailer's permittee or an  $[\frac{1}{7}, \frac{1}{1}]$  officer of the permittee  $[\frac{1}{7}]$  may
- 10 <u>not</u> possess distilled spirits or liquor containing alcohol in
- 11 excess of 17 percent by volume on the licensed premises.
- 12 (b) The commission by rule may allow a wine and beer
- 13 retailer's permittee or the permittee's officer to possess and use
- 14 alcoholic beverages in excess of 17 percent by volume on the
- 15 licensed premises for cooking purposes.
- 16 SECTION 2. Section 28.06, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
- 17 amended by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 18 <u>(e)</u> The commission by rule may allow the holder of a mixed
- 19 beverage permit or an officer, agent, or employee of the permit
- 20 holder to possess and use alcoholic beverages that are not covered
- 21 by an invoice on the permitted premises for cooking purposes.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
