- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 487.001, Government Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 487.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
- 9 (1) "Board" means the <u>Department of Agriculture</u> [board
- 10 of the Office of Rural Community Affairs].
- 11 (2) "Commissioner" means the commissioner of
- 12 <u>agriculture.</u>
- 13 (3) "Department" means the Department of Agriculture.
- 14 (4) "Office" means the Office of Rural Community
- 15 Affairs within the department.
- 16 SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 487, Government Code, is
- 17 amended by adding Sections 487.003 and 487.004 to read as follows:
- 18 Sec. 487.003. OFFICE OF RURAL COMMUNITY AFFAIRS. The
- 19 Office of Rural Community Affairs is established within the
- 20 <u>department</u>.
- Sec. 487.004. REFERENCE IN LAW. A reference in this chapter
- 22 or other law to the board of the Office of Rural Community Affairs
- 23 means the commissioner.
- 24 SECTION 3. The following laws are repealed:

- 7 SECTION 4. (a) The Office of Rural Community Affairs is
- 8 abolished as an independent agency and created as a program in the
- 9 Department of Agriculture. The board of the Office of Rural
- 10 Community Affairs is abolished.
- 11 (b) The validity of an action taken by the Office of Rural
- 12 Community Affairs or its board before either is abolished under
- 13 Subsection (a) of this section is not affected by the abolishment.
- 14 SECTION 5. On September 1, 2009:
- 15 (1) the executive director of the Office of Rural
- 16 Community Affairs becomes the executive director of the Office of
- 17 Rural Community Affairs in the Department of Agriculture;
- 18 (2) an employee of the Office of Rural Community
- 19 Affairs becomes an employee of the Office of Rural Community
- 20 Affairs in the Department of Agriculture;
- 21 (3) a reference in law to the Office of Rural Community
- 22 Affairs means the Office of Rural Community Affairs in the
- 23 Department of Agriculture;
- 24 (4) all money, contracts, leases, rights, and
- 25 obligations of the Office of Rural Community Affairs are
- 26 transferred to the Office of Rural Community Affairs in the
- 27 Department of Agriculture;

- 1 (5) all property, including records, in the custody of
- 2 the Office of Rural Community Affairs becomes the property of the
- 3 Office of Rural Community Affairs in the Department of Agriculture;
- 4 and
- 5 (6) all funds appropriated by the legislature to the
- 6 Office of Rural Community Affairs are transferred to the Office of
- 7 Rural Community Affairs in the Department of Agriculture.
- 8 SECTION 6. A function or activity performed by the Office of
- 9 Rural Community Affairs is transferred to the Office of Rural
- 10 Community Affairs in the Department of Agriculture as provided by
- 11 this Act.
- 12 SECTION 7. The Office of Rural Community Affairs and the
- 13 Department of Agriculture shall establish a transition plan for the
- 14 transfer described in Section 5 of this Act.
- 15 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
