- 2 relating to the abolition of the Texas cultural endowment fund.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Sections 444.025(a), (b), and (i), Government
- 5 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) The commission may accept on behalf of the state
- 7 donations of money, property, and art objects as it determines best
- 8 further the orderly development of the artistic resources of the
- 9 state. Money [Except as provided by Subsection (b), money] paid to
- 10 the commission under this chapter shall be deposited in the Texas
- 11 Commission on the Arts operating [cultural endowment] fund.
- 12 (b) The commission may solicit donations from an
- 13 appropriate source. [A person may designate a donation as intended
- 14 for the Texas cultural endowment fund or the Texas Commission on the
- 15 Arts operating fund. If the person designates that a donation is
- 16 intended for a specific fund, the donation shall be deposited in the
- 17 designated fund.
- (i) All money paid to the commission under this chapter  $[\tau]$
- 19 other than money required to be deposited in the Texas cultural
- 20 endowment fund, is subject to Subchapter F, Chapter 404.
- SECTION 2. Section 444.032(c), Government Code, is amended
- 22 to read as follows:
- (c) All proceeds from the sale of compact discs under the
- 24 project shall be deposited in the Texas Commission on the Arts

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- 1 operating [cultural endowment] fund under Section 444.027
- $2 \left[ \frac{444.026}{} \right].$
- 3 SECTION 3. Sections 444.026 and 444.028, Government Code,
- 4 are repealed.
- 5 SECTION 4. (a) Before December 1, 2009, the Texas
- 6 Commission on the Arts, in consultation with interested
- 7 stakeholders, shall review donor restrictions on donations to the
- 8 Texas cultural endowment fund to determine if the donations may be
- 9 transferred to the Texas Commission on the Arts operating fund.
- 10 (b) On December 1, 2009:
- 11 (1) the Texas cultural endowment fund is abolished;
- 12 (2) the money, including any interest or income earned
- 13 before December 1, 2009, in the Texas cultural endowment fund that
- 14 is not subject to donor restrictions prohibiting the transfer is
- 15 transferred to the Texas Commission on the Arts operating fund; and
- 16 (3) the money, including any interest or income earned
- 17 before December 1, 2009, in the Texas cultural endowment fund that
- 18 is subject to donor restrictions prohibiting a transfer to the
- 19 Texas Commission on the Arts operating fund is returned to the
- 20 donor.
- (c) Money transferred under Subsection (b)(2) of this
- 22 section may not be used to reduce or eliminate appropriations made
- 23 for the fiscal biennium beginning September 1, 2009, to the Texas
- 24 Commission on the Arts.
- 25 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

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- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
