A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	relating to an emergency management plan for certain health care
3	facilities.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 418, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 418.049 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 418.049. EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR CERTAIN HEALTH
8	CARE FACILITIES. (a) The division shall review each emergency
9	management plan submitted under Sections 242.018, 246.008, and
10	247.007, Health and Safety Code, and suggest changes to a plan as
11	necessary to ensure safety of the residents of the facility or
12	<u>institution.</u>
13	(b) The division shall approve a plan as appropriate and
14	provide evidence of the division's approval to the facility or
15	institution.
16	SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 242, Health and Safety
17	Code, is amended by adding Section 242.018 to read as follows:
18	Sec. 242.018. EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PLAN. (a) Ar
19	institution shall prepare and keep current an emergency management
20	plan providing for disaster mitigation, preparedness, response,
21	and recovery.
22	(b) The plan must provide for:
23	(1) evacuation of the institution; and
24	(2) sheltering at the institution by the residents for

- 1 the duration of the emergency.
- 2 (c) Each institution shall submit the institution's
- 3 emergency management plan to the division of emergency management
- 4 in the governor's office and the city or county in which the
- 5 institution is located.
- 6 SECTION 3. Section 242.032, Health and Safety Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Subsection (c-1) to read as follows:
- 8 <u>(c-1) Each applicant for a license or a renewal of a license</u>
- 9 shall submit evidence of approval of the institution's emergency
- 10 management plan under Section 242.018 by the emergency management
- 11 division in the governor's office.
- 12 SECTION 4. Subchapter A, Chapter 246, Health and Safety
- 13 Code, is amended by adding Section 246.008 to read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 246.008. EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PLAN. (a) Each
- 15 <u>facility shall prepare and keep current an emergency management</u>
- 16 plan providing for disaster mitigation, preparedness, response,
- 17 <u>and recovery.</u>
- 18 (b) The plan must provide for:
- 19 (1) evacuation of the facility; and
- 20 (2) sheltering at the facility by the residents for
- 21 the duration of the emergency.
- (c) Each facility shall submit the facility's emergency
- 23 management plan to the division of emergency management in the
- 24 governor's office and the city or county in which the facility is
- 25 located.
- SECTION 5. Section 246.022(c), Health and Safety Code, is
- 27 amended to read as follows:

- 1 (c) The commissioner shall grant an application for a
- 2 certificate of authority if the commissioner finds that:
- 3 (1) the applicant or the facility is financially
- 4 sound;
- 5 (2) the competence, experience, and integrity of the
- 6 applicant, its board of directors, its officers, or its management
- 7 make it in the public interest to issue the certificate; [and]
- 8 (3) the applicant is capable of complying with this
- 9 chapter; and
- 10 (4) the applicant has submitted evidence of approval
- of the facility's emergency management plan under Section 246.008
- 12 by the emergency management division in the governor's office.
- SECTION 6. Subchapter A, Chapter 247, Health and Safety
- 14 Code, is amended by adding Section 247.007 to read as follows:
- Sec. 247.007. EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PLAN. (a) Each
- 16 <u>assisted living facility licensed in this state shall prepare and</u>
- 17 keep current an emergency management plan providing for disaster
- 18 mitigation, preparedness, response, and recovery.
- 19 (b) The plan must provide for:
- 20 (1) evacuation of the assisted living facility; and
- 21 (2) sheltering at the assisted living facility by the
- 22 facility residents for the duration of the emergency.
- 23 <u>(c) Each assisted living facility shall submit the</u>
- 24 facility's emergency management plan to the division of emergency
- 25 management in the governor's office and the city or county in which
- 26 the facility is located.
- 27 SECTION 7. Section 247.022, Health and Safety Code, is

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- 1 amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 2 (d) Each applicant for an assisted living facility license
- 3 or renewal of a license shall submit evidence of approval of the
- 4 facility's emergency management plan under Section 247.007 by the
- 5 emergency management division in the governor's office.
- 6 SECTION 8. A convalescent or nursing home, or related
- 7 institution licensed under Chapter 242, Health and Safety Code, a
- 8 continuing care facility granted a certificate of authority under
- 9 Chapter 246, Health and Safety Code, or an assisted living facility
- 10 licensed under Chapter 247, Health and Safety Code, shall develop
- 11 an emergency management plan as required by Sections 242.018,
- 12 246.008, and 247.007, Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act,
- 13 as soon as practicable after the effective date of this Act.
- 14 SECTION 9. The changes in law made by this Act apply to an
- 15 application for a certificate of authority, a license, or a renewal
- 16 of a license filed on or after the effective date of this Act. An
- 17 application filed before the effective date of this Act is governed
- 18 by the law in effect on the date of the filing of the application,
- 19 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 20 SECTION 10. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
