AN ACT

2	relating to the use of state hotel occupancy tax revenue to clear
3	and maintain beaches in certain municipalities.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

- 5 SECTION 1. Section 156.2512(c)(1), Tax Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (1) "Eligible barrier island coastal municipality"
- 8 means a municipality that is located wholly or partly on a barrier
- 9 island and:

- 10 (A) that borders on the Gulf of Mexico; or
- 11 (B) [that is located wholly or partly on a
- 12 barrier island; and
- [(C)] the boundaries of which [are within 30
- 14 miles of the United Mexican States or] include a portion of a
- 15 national seashore.
- 16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect on the first day of the
- 17 first month beginning on or after the earliest date on which this
- 18 Act may take effect if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the
- 19 members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article
- 20 III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote
- 21 necessary for effect on that date, this Act takes effect September
- 22 1, 2009.
