A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to extending the high school innovation grant initiative 3 to middle and junior high schools. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 39.115, Education Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 Sec. 39.115. [HICH SCHOOL] INNOVATION GRANT INITIATIVE FOR 7 MIDDLE, JUNIOR HIGH, AND HIGH SCHOOL CAMPUSES. 8 9 SECTION 2. Sections 39.115(a), (b), and (d), Education Code, are amended to read as follows: 10 11 (a) From funds appropriated for that purpose, the 12 commissioner may establish a grant program under which grants are awarded to middle, junior high, and high school [secondary] 13 14 campuses and school districts to support: 15 (1) the implementation of innovative [high school] 16 improvement programs that are based on the best available research regarding middle, junior high, or high school reform, dropout 17 prevention, and preparing students for postsecondary coursework or 18 employment; 19 20 (2) enhancing education practices that have been 21 demonstrated by significant evidence of effectiveness; and 22 (3) the alignment of grants and programs to the 23 strategic plan adopted under Section 39.357. 24 (b) Before awarding a grant under this section, the

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1 commissioner may require a campus or school district to:

2 (1) obtain local matching funds; or
3 (2) meet other conditions, including developing a
4 personal graduation plan under Section 28.0212 for each student
5 enrolled at the campus or in a district <u>middle</u>, junior high, or high
6 school.

7 (d) The commissioner may use funds appropriated under this
8 section to support technical assistance services for school
9 districts and open-enrollment charter schools to implement <u>an</u> [a
10 <u>high school</u>] improvement program under this section.

11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.

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
