4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 29, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 29.091 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 29.091. MIDDLE AND JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL GRANT PROGRAM
8	FOR AFTER-SCHOOL LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES. (a) From funds
9	appropriated for that purpose, the commissioner shall establish a
10	program under which grants are awarded to school districts to
11	implement after-school learning opportunities for students in
12	middle and junior high schools who are at risk of dropping out of
13	school, as described by Section 29.081(d).
14	(b) Activities funded with a grant under this section must
15	be designed to:
16	(1) promote the ability of students to succeed in
17	middle or junior high school;
18	(2) prepare students for the transition to high school
19	so that the students enter high school with the ability to succeed,
20	graduate, and successfully pursue postsecondary options;
21	(3) provide students with the opportunity to
22	investigate diverse career options; and
23	(4) provide students and their parents with
24	information regarding opportunities for higher education.

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H.B. No. 2264 (c) The commissioner shall establish application criteria 1 for receiving a grant under this section. The criteria must 2 require a school district that applies for a grant to collaborate 3 with local businesses and nonprofit organizations in providing 4 5 activities designed to achieve the goals described by Subsection 6 (b). 7 (d) The commissioner may: 8 (1) accept gifts, grants, or donations from a private foundation to implement a grant program under this section; and 9 (2) coordinate gifts, grants, or donations with other 10 available funding to implement a grant program under this section. 11 12 (e) The commissioner shall establish procedures for evaluating the effectiveness of activities funded with a grant 13 awarded under this section. The procedures must include 14 15 consideration of: (1) <u>school attendance rates;</u> 16 17 (2) student performance in academic subjects; and (3) subsequent high school completion rates. 18 (f) The commissioner shall adopt rules necessary to 19 administer the grant program under this section. 20 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 23 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

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Act takes effect September 1, 2009.

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
