- 5 SECTION 2. The Texas Department of Criminal Justice shall
- 6 establish and implement the local and regional discharge and

- 8 added by this Act, as soon as possible after September 1, 2009, and
- 9 in no event later than September 1, 2010.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
