## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the scope of services of and the persons who may be
3	provided services by a community center.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 531.002, Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended by adding Subdivision (13-a) to read as follows:
7	(13-a) "Person with a developmental disability" means
8	an individual with a severe, chronic disability attributable to a
9	mental or physical impairment or a combination of mental and
10	<pre>physical impairments that:</pre>
11	(A) manifests before the person reaches 22 years
12	of age;
13	(B) is likely to continue indefinitely;
14	(C) reflects the individual's need for a
15	combination and sequence of special, interdisciplinary, or generic
16	services, individualized supports, or other forms of assistance
17	that are of a lifelong or extended duration and are individually
18	planned and coordinated; and
19	(D) results in substantial functional
20	limitations in three or more of the following categories of major
21	<pre>life activity:</pre>
22	(i) self-care;
23	(ii) receptive and expressive language;
24	(iii) learning;

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1	<pre>(iv) mobility;</pre>
2	(v) self-direction;
3	(vi) capacity for independent living; and
4	(vii) economic self-sufficiency.
5	SECTION 2. Section 534.001(e), Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(e) Except as provided by this section, a $[A]$ community
8	center operating under this subchapter may operate only for the
9	purposes and perform only the functions defined in the center's
10	plan. The <u>executive commissioner</u> [board] by rule shall specify the
11	elements that must be included in a plan and shall prescribe the
12	procedure for submitting, approving, and modifying a center's plan.
13	In addition to the services described in a center's plan, the center
14	may provide other health and human services and supports as
15	provided by a contract with or a grant received from a local, state,
16	or federal agency.
17	SECTION 3. Section 534.0015(b), Health and Safety Code, is
18	amended to read as follows:
19	(b) It is the policy of this state that community centers
20	strive to develop services for persons who are mentally ill or

- SECTION 4. Section 534.0155(a), Health and Safety Code, is 25
- 26 amended to read as follows:
- 27 (a) This subtitle does not prevent a community center from

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- 1 providing services to a person with  $\underline{a}$  chemical dependency,  $[\underline{or}]$  to  $\underline{a}$
- 2 person with a developmental disability, or to a person with a mental
- 3 disability, as [that term is] defined by Section 535.001.
- 4 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
