A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to requiring school districts to report compliance with

- 3 physical activity requirements.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 28.002, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (1) and adding Subsection (1-4) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (1) A school district shall require a student enrolled in
- 9 kindergarten or a grade level below grade six to participate in
- 10 moderate or vigorous daily physical activity for at least 30
- 11 minutes throughout the school year as part of the district's
- 12 physical education curriculum or through structured activity
- 13 during a school campus's daily recess. A school district shall
- 14 require students enrolled in grade levels six, seven, and eight to
- 15 participate in moderate or vigorous daily physical activity for at
- 16 least 30 minutes for at least four semesters during those grade
- 17 levels as part of the district's physical education curriculum. It
- 18 a school district determines, for any particular grade level below
- 19 grade six, that requiring moderate or vigorous daily physical
- 20 activity is impractical due to scheduling concerns or other
- 21 factors, the district may as an alternative require a student in
- 22 that grade level to participate in moderate or vigorous physical
- 23 activity for at least 135 minutes during each school week.
- 24 Additionally, a school district may as an alternative require a

- 1 student enrolled in a grade level for which the district uses block
- 2 scheduling to participate in moderate or vigorous physical activity
- 3 for at least 225 minutes during each period of two school weeks. A
- 4 school campus may not fulfill the requirements of this subsection
- 5 with unstructured activity or recess. A school district must
- 6 provide for an exemption for:
- 7 (1) any student who is unable to participate in the
- 8 required physical activity because of illness or disability; and
- 9 (2) a middle school or junior high school student who
- 10 participates in an extracurricular activity with a moderate or
- 11 vigorous physical activity component that is considered a
- 12 structured activity under rules adopted by the commissioner.
- 13 (1-4) Not later than the 30th day before the first day of
- 14 instruction of the school year, each elementary and middle school
- 15 campus in a school district shall submit to the district the daily
- 16 or weekly schedule of moderate or vigorous physical activity to be
- 17 used by that campus during that school year. Not later than the
- 18 60th day after the first day of instruction of the school year, each
- 19 district shall review the schedules for compliance with Subsection
- 20 (1) and submit a report to the agency listing which campuses of the
- 21 district are in compliance and which campuses of the district are
- 22 <u>not in compliance.</u>
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2009-2010
- 24 school year.
- 25 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

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- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
