- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 63.0101, Election Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 63.0101. DOCUMENTATION OF PROOF OF IDENTIFICATION.
- 9 <u>(a)</u> The following documentation is acceptable as proof of
- 10 identification under this chapter:
- 11 (1) a driver's license or personal identification card
- 12 issued to the person by the Department of Public Safety or a similar
- 13 document issued to the person by an agency of another state,
- 14 regardless of whether the license or card has expired;
- 15 (2) a form of identification containing the person's
- 16 photograph that establishes the person's identity;
- 17 (3) a birth certificate or other document confirming
- 18 birth that is admissible in a court of law and establishes the
- 19 person's identity;
- 20 (4) United States citizenship papers issued to the
- 21 person;
- 22 (5) a United States passport issued to the person;
- 23 (6) official mail addressed to the person by name from
- 24 a governmental entity;

- 1 (7) a copy of a current utility bill, bank statement,
- 2 government check, paycheck, or other government document that shows
- 3 the name and address of the voter; or
- 4 (8) any other form of identification prescribed by the
- 5 secretary of state.
- 6 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, a state or local
- 7 governmental entity may not charge a fee for the issuance of a
- 8 document that a person may present as proof of identification in
- 9 order for the person to be accepted for voting.
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
