- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 601.072, Transportation Code, is amended
- 7 by adding Subsections (a-2) and (a-3) to read as follows:
- 8 <u>(a-2)</u> A person convicted of an offense relating to the
- 9 operating of a motor vehicle while intoxicated must maintain, in
- 10 addition to the minimum coverage required by this section,
- 11 <u>additional liability insurance coverage to establish financial</u>
- 12 responsibility under this chapter. The amount of liability
- 13 coverage required increases by \$25,000 for each conviction.
- 14 (a-3) In this section, "offense relating to the operating of
- 15 <u>a motor vehicle while intoxicated" has the meaning assigned by</u>
- 16 Section 49.09, Penal Code.
- 17 SECTION 2. Section 601.072, Transportation Code, as amended
- 18 by this Act, applies only to an offense committed on or after the
- 19 effective date of this Act. An offense committed before the
- 20 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect
- 21 immediately before that date, and the former law is continued in
- 22 effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense
- 23 was committed before the effective date of this Act if any element
- 24 of the offense occurred before that date.
