H.B. No. 2342

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to requiring certain school districts to use county election precincts.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 42.002(a), Election Code, is amended to read as follows:

(a) The county election precincts are the election precincts for the following elections:

(1) the general election for state and county officers;

(2) a special election ordered by the governor;

(3) a primary election;

(4) a countywide election ordered by the commissioners court, county judge, or other county authority, except an election subject to Section 42.062(2); and

(5) as provided by Section 42.0621, any other election held on the November uniform election date of:

(A) a school district with a student enrollment of more than 750 located in any county; and

(B) a political subdivision, other than a school district, not located in a county with a population of more than 3.3 million or a county adjacent to a county with a population of more than 3.3 million.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
