6	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 2003, Government Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 2003.058 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 2003.058. INTERNET REPORT. (a) The office shall post
9	on the office's Internet website at least once each quarter a report
10	on the total number of cases heard by each administrative law judge
11	employed by the office during the previous quarter.
12	(b) A report must be posted not later than the 30th day after
13	the last day of the quarter and must include:
14	(1) the name of each administrative law judge;
15	(2) the number of cases heard by the administrative
16	law judge during the quarter;
17	(3) the municipality, county, or region in which the
18	hearing was conducted or the final ruling was made;
19	(4) the category the office assigned to each case;
20	(5) the number of cases in which the administrative
21	law judge's decision was favorable to the state; and
22	(6) the number of cases in which the administrative
23	law judge's decision in favor of the state was appealed to the

courts and upheld by the reviewing court.
