A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to participation by certain educational aides in a school 3 district's mentoring program.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 21.458, Education Code, is amended by 6 adding Subsection (a-1) and amending Subsection (c) to read as 7 follows:

8 <u>(a-1) Each school district may assign a mentor to each</u> 9 <u>educational aide who has less than one year of classroom</u> 10 <u>experience. A person assigned as a mentor under this subsection is</u> 11 <u>not required to be a teacher and is not subject to the requirements</u> 12 <u>prescribed by Subsections (a) and (b) that apply to a mentor teacher</u> 13 <u>assigned to mentor a classroom teacher.</u>

14 (c) From the funds appropriated to the agency for purposes 15 of this section, the commissioner shall adopt rules and provide 16 funding to school districts that assign <u>mentors</u> [mentor teachers] 17 under this section. Funding provided to districts under this 18 section may be used only for providing:

(1) mentor [teacher] stipends;

20 (2) scheduled time for <u>mentors</u> [mentor teachers] to
21 provide mentoring to assigned classroom teachers <u>and educational</u>
22 <u>aides</u>; and

(3) mentoring support through providers of mentor24 training.

H.B. No. 2351 1 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2009-2010 2 school year.

3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
