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## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the sale of a cemetery plot; providing a criminal
3	penalty.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 711.001, Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended by adding Subdivision (2-a) to read as follows:
7	(2-a) "Cemetery broker" means a person who sells the
8	exclusive right of sepulture for another person. The term does not
9	include a person who:
10	(A) is an officer, agent, or employee of the
11	cemetery organization in which the plot is located; or
12	(B) originally purchased the exclusive right of
13	sepulture for personal use.
14	SECTION 2. Section 711.012(a), Health and Safety Code, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	(a) The Finance Commission of Texas may adopt rules to
17	enforce and administer:
18	<u>(1)</u> Sections 711.003, 711.008, 711.021-711.024,
19	711.032-711.035, 711.038, <u>711.0381</u> , 711.040-711.042, 711.052,
20	711.061, and 711.062 relating to perpetual care cemeteries; and
21	(2) Subchapter C-1 relating to registration of
22	cemetery brokers.
23	SECTION 3. The heading to Section 711.038, Health and
24	Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:

1	Sec. 711.038. SALE OF PLOTS BY CEMETERY ORGANIZATIONS.
2	SECTION 4. Section 711.038, Health and Safety Code, is
3	amended by amending Subsection (e) and adding Subsection (f) to
4	read as follows:
5	(e) A person who is an officer, agent, or employee of the
6	cemetery organization or its affiliate is not required to be
7	licensed to sell a plot in a dedicated cemetery.
8	(f) The Texas Department of Banking shall provide model
9	quitclaim agreements or other instruments of conveyance for use in
10	transferring the exclusive right of sepulture under this section.
11	A cemetery organization may modify the model forms to include
12	additional provisions considered necessary to conform to the
13	practices and policies of the cemetery organization in which the
14	plot is located.
15	SECTION 5. Subchapter C, Chapter 711, Health and Safety
16	Code, is amended by adding Section 711.0381 to read as follows:
17	Sec. 711.0381. RESALE OF PLOTS BY CERTAIN PERSONS. (a) A
18	person may not act as a cemetery broker in the resale of the
19	exclusive right of sepulture in a plot unless the person is a
20	registered cemetery broker or is exempt from registration under
21	Subchapter C-1.
22	(b) Resale of the exclusive right of sepulture in a plot is
23	subject to the rules of the cemetery organization and any
24	restrictions in the certificate of ownership, quitclaim agreement,
25	or other instrument of conveyance. A quitclaim agreement or other
26	instrument evidencing the conveyance of the exclusive right of
27	sepulture must be:

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1	(1) in a form authorized by or otherwise acceptable to
2	the cemetery organization, subject to Subsection (c);
3	(2) signed by:
4	(A) the grantee named in the certificate of
5	ownership or other instrument of conveyance as filed and recorded
6	in the cemetery organization's office in accordance with Section
7	711.038, as the seller or transferor;
8	(B) the designated purchaser or transferee; and
9	(C) each cemetery broker or other agent assisting
10	in the transfer of the interment rights; and
11	(3) filed and recorded with the cemetery organization
12	not later than the third business day after the date of the sale.
13	(c) On request of a person acting as a cemetery broker, a
14	cemetery organization shall provide its rules, conveyance forms,
15	and written guidelines and procedures for brokered sales, if any.
16	(d) The sale of the exclusive right of sepulture in a group
17	of interment rights that were conveyed collectively may not be
18	divided without the consent of the cemetery organization.
19	(e) A person acting as a cemetery broker that sells the
20	right of sepulture in a plot shall collect and remit to the cemetery
21	organization:
22	(1) all fees required under Section 712.028; and
23	(2) any other fee required by the rules of the cemetery
24	organization subject to Subsection (f).
25	(f) A fee required by a rule of the cemetery organization
26	for the sale of the right of sepulture in a plot under this section
27	may not exceed the fee charged on the sale of the right of sepulture

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1	in a plot by the cemetery organization under Section 711.038.
2	(g) A person acting as a cemetery broker must keep a record
3	of each sale under this section. The record must include:
4	(1) the name and address of the purchaser;
5	(2) the date of the purchase;
6	(3) a copy of the purchase agreement, with the name and
7	address of the cemetery;
8	(4) a specific description of the interment rights;
9	(5) the purchase price;
10	(6) the amount of fees collected and remitted in
11	accordance with Subsection (e); and
12	(7) information on the disposal of the purchase
13	agreement, including whether the agreement was conveyed, canceled,
14	or voided.
15	SECTION 6. Chapter 711, Health and Safety Code, is amended
16	by adding Subchapter C-1 to read as follows:
17	SUBCHAPTER C-1. CEMETERY BROKER REGISTRATION
18	Sec. 711.045. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:
19	(1) "Commission" means the Finance Commission of
20	Texas.
21	(2) "Commissioner" means the banking commissioner of
22	Texas.
23	(3) "Department" means the Texas Department of
24	Banking.
25	Sec. 711.046. CEMETERY BROKER REGISTRATION. (a) A person
26	may not act as a cemetery broker in the sale of the exclusive right
27	of sepulture in a plot unless the person is registered under this

1 subchapter as a cemetery broker or is exempt from registration under Section 711.047. To register under this subchapter, a 2 3 cemetery broker shall file with the department a sworn, notarized statement that contains: 4 5 (1) the name and address of the cemetery broker; 6 (2) the name, address, and telephone number of the 7 representative of the cemetery broker to be contacted regarding a 8 written complaint; and 9 (3) any Internet or other electronic mail address of the cemetery broker. 10 (b) The registration of a cemetery broker is valid until 11 12 withdrawn or revoked. Periodic renewal of the registration is not 13 required. 14 (c) A registered cemetery broker shall update the 15 information contained in the registration statement not later than the 60th day after the date the information changes. 16 17 (d) The department may charge a cemetery broker a reasonable fee to cover the costs of filing and maintaining the registration 18 19 statement and administering this chapter. The administration fee 20 may not exceed \$100 per year. 21 Sec. 711.047. EXEMPTIONS. This subchapter does not apply 22 to a person offering to sell or selling the exclusive right of sepulture in a plot if the person is: 23 24 (1) an officer, agent, employee, or affiliate of the cemetery organization in which the plot is located, acting at the 25 26 direction or under the control of the cemetery organization; 27 (2) an employee of a registered cemetery broker;

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1	(3) with respect to the specific plot for sale:
2	(A) a grantee named in the certificate of
3	ownership or other instrument of conveyance for the plot as filed
4	and recorded in the cemetery organization's office under Section
5	<u>711.038;</u>
6	(B) a spouse or other heir of the named grantee as
7	described by Section 711.039;
8	(C) an executor, administrator, or guardian of
9	the named grantee appointed by court order; or
10	(D) an attorney-in-fact for the named grantee
11	under a durable power of attorney if the person is not otherwise
12	engaged in the business of a cemetery broker and does not solicit
13	appointment as attorney-in-fact for the purpose of offering to sell
14	or selling the exclusive right of sepulture of the named grantee; or
15	(4) otherwise exempt in accordance with rules adopted
16	by the commission as necessary to protect the public health and
17	<u>safety.</u>
18	Sec. 711.048. PUBLIC INFORMATION; COMPLAINTS. (a) The
19	department shall prepare a brochure with information of public
20	interest:
21	(1) explaining matters relating to the resale of plots
22	by a cemetery broker, including disclosure that the sale is not
23	complete until registered with the cemetery organization; and
24	(2) describing the department's procedures for filing
25	and resolving a complaint.
26	(b) The department shall:
27	(1) provide each registered cemetery broker with the

1	number of brochures the department considers appropriate for a fee
2	to recover the department's costs; and
3	(2) make the brochure available to the public and
4	appropriate state agencies.
5	(c) A cemetery broker shall provide the brochure on the
6	initial inquiry to the cemetery broker by a plot owner or the
7	representative of a plot owner regarding the potential resale of
8	the exclusive right of sepulture in the plot.
9	(d) A cemetery broker is subject to rules adopted under
10	Section 11.307, Finance Code, regarding the manner in which the
11	cemetery broker provides consumers with information on how to file
12	complaints with the department. The rules must be consistent with
13	the obligations imposed by this section.
14	(e) If the department receives a signed written complaint
15	from a person concerning a cemetery broker, the department shall
16	notify the cemetery broker's designated representative in writing
17	of the complaint not later than the 31st day after the date the
18	complaint was received and provide a copy of the complaint to the
19	representative. The department may:
20	(1) require the cemetery broker to resolve the
21	complaint or to provide the department with a response to the
22	<pre>complaint; or</pre>
23	(2) direct the cemetery broker in writing to take
24	specific action to resolve the complaint.
25	Sec. 711.049. TERMINATION OF REGISTRATION. (a) A cemetery
26	broker may withdraw the cemetery broker's registration at any time.
27	(b) After notice and hearing, the commissioner may revoke

1	the registration of a registered cemetery broker that:
2	(1) fails to pay the annual administration fee and
3	fails to cure the default not later than the 30th day after the date
4	written notice of the default is mailed by the department to the
5	cemetery broker;
6	(2) fails or refuses to comply with the department's
7	written request for a response to a complaint; or
8	(3) the commissioner concludes, after considering a
9	complaint filed under this chapter, has engaged in an intentional
10	course of conduct that:
11	(A) violates federal or state law; or
12	(B) constitutes improper, fraudulent, or
13	dishonest dealings.
14	(c) The commissioner shall state the basis of the decision
15	in an order revoking the registration of a cemetery broker. The
16	cemetery broker may appeal an order revoking registration in the
17	manner provided by Chapter 2001, Government Code.
18	SECTION 7. Section 711.052(a), Health and Safety Code, is
19	amended to read as follows:
20	(a) A person who is an individual, firm, association,
21	corporation, or municipality, or an officer, agent, or employee of
22	an individual, firm, association, corporation, or municipality,
23	commits an offense if the person:
24	(1) engages in a business for cemetery purposes in
25	this state other than through a corporation organized for that
26	purpose, if a corporation is required by law;
27	(2) fails or refuses to keep records of interment as

1 required by Sections 711.003 and 711.004;

2 (3) sells, offers to sell, or advertises for sale a
3 plot or the exclusive right of sepulture in a plot for purposes of
4 speculation or investment; [<del>or</del>]

5 (4) represents through advertising or printed material that a retail department will be established for the 6 resale of the plots of plot purchasers, that specific improvements 7 8 will be made in the cemetery, or that specific merchandise or services will be furnished to a plot owner, unless adequate funds or 9 10 reserves are created by the cemetery organization for the represented purpose; 11

12 (5) offers or receives monetary inducement to solicit
13 <u>business for a cemetery broker;</u>

14 (6) fails or refuses to keep records of resales or to 15 collect and remit fees as required by Section 711.0381; or

16 <u>(7)</u> fails or refuses to register as a cemetery broker
17 as required by Subchapter C-1.

18 SECTION 8. (a) Except as provided by Subsections (b) and 19 (c) of this section, this Act takes effect immediately if it 20 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each 21 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. 22 Except as provided by Subsections (b) and (c) of this section, if 23 this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, 24 this Act takes effect September 1, 2009.

(b) Section 711.038(f), Health and Safety Code, as added by
this Act, takes effect September 1, 2010.

27 (c) Subchapter C-1, Chapter 711, Health and Safety Code, as

1 added by this Act, takes effect January 1, 2010, except that 2 Sections 711.048(a) through (c), Health and Safety Code, as added 3 by this Act, take effect September 1, 2010.

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
