H.B. No. 2384

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to certain mammography systems that fail certification 3 standards. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 401.430(f), Health and Safety Code, is 5 amended to read as follows: 6 (f) If a facility's mammography system fails to meet the 7 department's certification standards and the failure is a Severity 8 Level I violation under the department's rules, the facility shall 9 notify each patient on whom the facility performed a mammography 10 during the period in which the system failed to meet the 11 12 department's certification standards [30 days preceding the date of 13 the inspection that revealed the failure]. The facility shall: 14 (1) inform the patient that the mammography system failed to satisfy the department's certification standards; 15 (2) recommend that the patient consult with the 16 patient's physician regarding the need for another mammogram [have 17 another mammogram performed at a facility with a certified 18 mammography system]; and 19 20 (3) list the three facilities closest to the original 21 testing facility that have a certified mammography system. 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.

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
