- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 51.002(b) and (e), Property Code, are
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (b-1), notice of the
- 8 sale, which must include a statement of the earliest time at which
- 9 the sale will begin, must be given at least 21 days before the date
- 10 of the sale by:
- 11 (1) posting at the courthouse door of each county in
- 12 which the property is located a written notice designating the
- 13 county in which the property will be sold;
- 14 (2) filing in the office of the county clerk of each
- 15 county in which the property is located a copy of the notice posted
- 16 under Subdivision (1); and
- 17 (3) serving written notice of the sale by certified
- 18 mail on<u>:</u>
- 19 <u>(A)</u> each debtor who, according to the records of
- 20 the mortgage servicer of the debt, is obligated to pay the debt; and
- 21 (B) each holder of a lien on the property subject
- 22 to foreclosure, as reflected in the real property records of the
- 23 county in which the property is located.
- (e) Service of a notice under this section by certified mail

- 1 is complete when the notice is deposited in the United States mail,
- 2 postage prepaid and addressed to the <u>person described by Subsection</u>
- 3 $\underline{\text{(b)(3)}}$ [debtor] at the person's [debtor's] last known address. The
- 4 affidavit of a person knowledgeable of the facts to the effect that
- 5 service was completed is prima facie evidence of service.
- 6 SECTION 2. Sections 209.010(a) and (b), Property Code, are
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (a) A property owners' association that conducts a
- 9 foreclosure sale of an owner's lot must send, [to the lot owner] not
- 10 later than the 30th day after the date of the foreclosure sale $\underline{\,}$ a
- 11 written notice stating the date and time the sale occurred to:
- 12 (1) the lot owner [and] informing the [lot] owner of
- 13 the owner's right to redeem the property under Section 209.011; and
- 14 (2) each record holder of a lien on the property sold
- 15 <u>at the foreclosure sale</u>.
- 16 (b) The notice must be sent by certified mail, return
- 17 receipt requested, to the [lot owner's] last known mailing address
- 18 of:
- 19 <u>(1)</u> the lot owner, as reflected in the records of the
- 20 property owners' association; and
- 21 (2) each record holder of a lien on the property sold
- 22 at the foreclosure sale, as reflected in the real property records
- 23 of the county in which the property is located.
- SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 25 a notice required to be provided on or after September 1, 2009. A
- 26 notice required to be provided before September 1, 2009, is
- 27 governed by the law in effect immediately before that date, and that

- 1 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 2 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
