- Sec. 107.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
- 11 (1) "Child pornography" means an image of a child
- 12 <u>engaging in sexual conduct or sexual performance.</u>
- 13 (2) "Computer technician" means an individual who, in
- 14 the course and scope of employment or business, installs, repairs,
- 15 or otherwise services a computer for a fee.
- 16 (3) "Sexual conduct" and "sexual performance" have the
- 17 meanings assigned by Section 43.25, Penal Code.
- 18 Sec. 107.002. REPORTING OF IMAGES OF CHILD PORNOGRAPHY.
- 19 (a) A computer technician who, in the course and scope of
- 20 employment or business, views an image on a computer that is or
- 21 appears to be child pornography shall immediately report the
- 22 discovery of the image to a local or state law enforcement agency or
- 23 the Cyber Tipline at the National Center for Missing and Exploited
- 24 Children. The report must include the name and address of the owner

- 1 or person claiming a right to possession of the computer, if known.
- 2 (b) A computer technician may not be held liable on account
- 3 of any action taken in good faith to comply with this section.
- 4 Sec. 107.003. CRIMINAL PENALTY. (a) A person who violates
- 5 this chapter commits an offense. An offense under this subsection
- 6 <u>is a Class B misdemeanor.</u>
- 7 (b) It is a defense to prosecution under this section that
- 8 the actor did not report the discovery of an image of child
- 9 pornography because the child in the image appeared to be at least
- 10 18 years of age.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
