- 2 relating to the state sales tax rate and creation of the education
- 3 equalization fund to equalize funding among school districts.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 151.051(b), Tax Code, is amended to read
- 6 as follows:
- 7 (b) The sales tax rate is $\underline{\text{seven}}$ [6-1/4] percent of the sales
- 8 price of the taxable item sold.
- 9 SECTION 2. Sections 151.801(a) and (c), Tax Code, are
- 10 amended to read as follows:
- 11 (a) Except for the amounts allocated under Subsections (b)
- 12 and (c) and Section 151.803, all proceeds from the collection of the
- 13 taxes imposed by this chapter shall be deposited to the credit of
- 14 the general revenue fund.
- 15 (c) Except for the amount allocated under Section 151.803
- 16 and subject [Subject] to Subsection (c-1), the proceeds from the
- 17 collection of the taxes imposed by this chapter on the sale,
- 18 storage, or use of sporting goods shall be deposited as follows:
- 19 (1) an amount equal to 94 percent of the proceeds shall
- 20 be credited to the Parks and Wildlife Department and deposited as
- 21 specified in the Parks and Wildlife Code; and
- 22 (2) an amount equal to six percent of the proceeds
- 23 shall be credited to the Texas Historical Commission and deposited
- 24 as specified in Section 442.073, Government Code.

- 1 SECTION 3. Subchapter M, Chapter 151, Tax Code, is amended
- 2 by adding Section 151.803 to read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 151.803. ALLOCATION OF CERTAIN REVENUE TO EDUCATION
- 4 EQUALIZATION FUND OR PROPERTY TAX RELIEF FUND. All proceeds, other
- 5 than the amount of the proceeds allocated under Section 151.801(b),
- 6 from the collection of taxes imposed by this chapter attributable
- 7 to the portion of the tax rate in excess of 6.25 percent shall be
- 8 deposited, as determined by the legislature, to the credit of the
- 9 education equalization fund under Chapter 47, Education Code, or
- 10 the property tax relief fund under Section 403.109, Government
- 11 Code.
- 12 SECTION 4. Subtitle I, Title 2, Education Code, is amended
- 13 by adding Chapter 47 to read as follows:
- 14 CHAPTER 47. EDUCATION EQUALIZATION
- 15 Sec. 47.001. EDUCATION EQUALIZATION FUND. (a) The
- 16 <u>education equalization fund is a special fund in the state treasury</u>
- 17 outside the general revenue fund. The fund is exempt from the
- 18 application of Sections 403.095 and 404.071, Government Code.
- 19 Interest and income from the deposit and investment of money in the
- 20 fund must be allocated monthly to the fund.
- 21 (b) Money in the fund may be used only to equalize
- 22 maintenance and operations funding among school districts as
- 23 <u>determined by appropriation</u>.
- SECTION 5. The change in law made by this Act does not
- 25 affect tax liability accruing before the effective date of this
- 26 Act. That liability continues in effect as if this Act had not been
- 27 enacted, and the former law is continued in effect for the

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- 1 collection of taxes due and for civil and criminal enforcement of
- 2 the liability for those taxes.
- 3 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
