5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 521.451(a), Transportation Code, is
7	amended to read as follows:
8	(a) Except as provided by Section 521.452, a person may not:
9	(1) [display, cause or permit to be displayed, or have
10	in the person's possession a driver's license or certificate that
11	the person knows is fictitious or has been altered;
12	$[\frac{(2)}{2}]$ lend the person's driver's license or
13	certificate to another person or knowingly permit another person to
14	use the person's driver's license or certificate;
15	(2) [(3)] display or represent as the person's own a
16	driver's license or certificate not issued to the person; or
17	(3) [(4)] possess more than one currently valid
18	driver's license or more than one currently valid certificate [; or
19	[(5) in an application for an original, renewal, or
20	duplicate driver's license or certificate:
21	[(A) provide a false name, false address, or a
22	counterfeit document; or
23	[(B) knowingly make a false statement, conceal a
24	material fact, or otherwise commit fraud].

- 1 SECTION 2. Section 521.454(c), Transportation Code, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 (c) An offense under this section is a <u>felony of the third</u>
- 4 degree [Class A misdemeanor].
- 5 SECTION 3. Section 521.455, Transportation Code, is
- 6 repealed.
- 7 SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 8 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 9 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 10 covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the
- 11 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of
- 12 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of
- 13 this Act if any element of the offense was committed before that
- 14 date.
- 15 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
