A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the enforcement of a court order requiring an inmate
- 3 imprisoned in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice to pay child
- 4 support.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 501.014(e), Government Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (e) On notification by a court, the department shall
- 9 withdraw from an inmate's account any amount the inmate is ordered
- 10 to pay by order of the court under this subsection. On receipt of a
- 11 valid court order requiring an inmate to pay child support, the
- 12 department shall withdraw the appropriate amount from the inmate's
- 13 <u>account under this subsection</u>, regardless of whether the court
- 14 order is provided by the court or another person. The department
- 15 shall make a payment under this subsection as ordered by the court
- 16 to either the court or the party specified in the court order. The
- 17 department is not liable for withdrawing or failing to withdraw
- 18 money or making payments or failing to make payments under this
- 19 subsection. The department shall make withdrawals and payments
- 20 from an inmate's account under this subsection according to the
- 21 following schedule of priorities:
- 22 (1) as payment in full for all orders for child
- 23 support;
- 24 (2) as payment in full for all orders for restitution;

- 1 (3) as payment in full for all orders for
- 2 reimbursement of the <u>Health and</u> [Texas Department of] Human
- 3 Services Commission for financial assistance provided for the
- 4 child's health needs under Chapter 31, Human Resources Code, to a
- 5 child of the inmate;
- 6 (4) as payment in full for all orders for court fees
- 7 and costs;
- 8 (5) as payment in full for all orders for fines; and
- 9 (6) as payment in full for any other court order,
- 10 judgment, or writ.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
