- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 39.151(g) and (g-1), Utilities Code,

- 9 regional electrical network that is located entirely in this state.
- 10 The [an] organization's governing body must be composed of persons
- 11 specified by this section and selected in accordance with formal
- 12 bylaws or protocols of the organization. The bylaws or protocols
- 13 must be approved by the commission and must reflect the input of the
- 14 commission. The bylaws must [specify the process by which
- 15 appropriate stakeholders elect members and, for unaffiliated
- 16 members, prescribe the professional qualifications necessary for
- 17 selection as a member of the organization and [. The bylaws must]
- 18 require the use of a professional search firm to identify
- 19 candidates for membership of unaffiliated members. The process
- 20 must allow for commission input in identifying candidates. The

No. 2421 representing residential and small commercial consumer interests; 1 the chief executive officer of the independent 2 3 organization as an ex officio voting member; 4 (4)[six market participants elected by their 5 respective market segments to serve one-year terms, with: [(A) one representing independent generators; 6 7 [(B) one representing investor-owned utilities; 8 [(C) one representing power marketers; [(D) one representing retail electric providers; 9 10 [(E) one representing municipally owned 11 utilities; and [(F) one representing electric cooperatives; 12 $\left[\frac{(5)}{(5)}\right]$ one member representing industrial consumer 13 14 interests and elected by the industrial consumer market segment to 15 serve a one-year term; 16 (5) $[\frac{(6)}{(6)}]$ one member representing large commercial 17 consumer interests selected in accordance with the bylaws to serve a one-year term; and 18 (6) nine $[\frac{(7) \text{ five}}]$ members unaffiliated with any 19 market segment and selected by the other members of the governing 20 body to serve three-year terms. 21 (g-1) The presiding officer of the governing body must be
- one of the members described by Subsection (g)(6) $\left[\frac{g}{f}\right]$. 23 24 SECTION 2. Not later than September 1, 2010, an independent organization that is certified by the commission before September 25 1, 2009, shall modify the organization's governing body to comply 26 with Section 39.151(q), Utilities Code, as amended by this Act.
