- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Subchapter G, Chapter 231, Local
- 6 Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 SUBCHAPTER G. ZONING AROUND LAKE ALAN HENRY, LAKE COOPER, LAKE
- 8 RALPH HALL, [AND] POST LAKE, AND LOWER BOIS D'ARC CREEK RESERVOIR
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 231.131(a), Local Government Code, is
- 10 amended to read as follows:
- 11 (a) The legislature finds that:
- 12 (1) the areas that surround Lake Alan Henry, Lake
- 13 Cooper, Lake Ralph Hall, [and] Post Lake, and Lower Bois D'Arc Creek
- 14 Reservoir are or will be frequented for recreational purposes by
- 15 residents from every part of the state;
- 16 (2) orderly development and use of the area is of
- 17 concern to the entire state; and
- 18 (3) buildings in the area that will be frequented for
- 19 resort or recreational purposes will tend to become congested and
- 20 to be used in ways that interfere with the proper use of the area as
- 21 a place of recreation to the detriment of the public health, safety,
- 22 morals, and general welfare.
- SECTION 3. Sections 231.132(a) and (b), Local Government
- 24 Code, are amended to read as follows:

- 1 (a) This subchapter applies to:
- 2 (1) those parts of Garza County located within three
- 3 miles of the high water marks established for Lake Alan Henry and
- 4 Post Lake except land located in Garza County and owned by the White
- 5 River Municipal Water District;
- 6 (2) those parts of Kent County located within three
- 7 miles of the high water marks established for Lake Alan Henry;
- 8 (3) the area within 10,000 feet of where the shoreline
- 9 of Lake Cooper would be if the lake were filled to its storage
- 10 capacity; [and]
- 11 (4) the area within 5,000 feet of where the shoreline
- 12 of Lake Ralph Hall would be if the lake were filled to its storage
- 13 capacity; and
- 14 (5) the area within 5,000 feet of where the shoreline
- of the Lower Bois D'Arc Creek Reservoir would be if the reservoir
- 16 were filled to its storage capacity.
- 17 (b) The areas described by Subsection (a) are subject to
- 18 regulation under this subchapter regardless of whether the
- 19 construction of an affected lake or reservoir is complete.
- SECTION 4. Section 231.132(c), Local Government Code, is
- 21 repealed.
- 22 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
