(1) "Public right-of-way" has the meaning assigned by

(2) "Publish" means to communicate information or make

Sec. 2003.002. INTERNET PUBLICATION OF CERTAIN IMAGES OF
PRIVATE PROPERTY PROHIBITED. (a) Except as provided by Subsection
(b), a person may not publish through the Internet, or cause to
publish through the Internet, an image capable of zooming into
greater detail than that of an aerial photograph taken without a
magnifying lens 300 feet or higher of private property not visible
