1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to the authority of a county to clarify the existence of a
1-11 public interest in certain roads.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. Section 258.007, Transportation Code, is amended
1-14 to read as follows:

1-15 Sec. 258.007. APPLICATION [~~EXPIRATION~~] OF CHAPTER. This
1-16 chapter applies only to a county that initiates or completes
1-17 compliance with the provisions of this chapter before [~~expires~~]
1-18 September 1, 2011 [~~2009~~].

1-19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-23 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
