## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 122.036, Election Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (a) The examiners shall examine the voting system or voting
- 9 system equipment for which an application has been submitted at the
- 10 time and in the manner directed by the secretary of state except
- 11 that:
- 12 (1) the examination must occur at an open meeting
- 13 <u>subject to Chapter 551, Government Code; and</u>
- 14 (2) an audiovisual recording of the examination must
- 15 be created and made available to the public on request.
- 16 (c) Subchapter B, Chapter 2001, Government Code, applies to
- 17 all proposed certification examinations and decisions made as a
- 18 result of those examinations by the secretary of state under this
- 19 subchapter.
- SECTION 2. Section 122.068, Election Code, is amended to
- 21 read as follows:
- Sec. 122.068. EXAMINATION AND REPORT BY EXAMINERS. (a) The
- 23 examiners shall examine the modified system or equipment and
- 24 prepare and deliver examination reports in the same manner as for an

- 1 application for initial approval of a system or equipment.
- 2 (b) Subchapter B, Chapter 2001, Government Code, applies to
- 3 all proposed modification examinations and certification decisions
- 4 made as a result of those examinations by the secretary of state
- 5 under this subchapter.
- 6 SECTION 3. Section 122.093, Election Code, is amended by
- 7 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (a) The examiners shall examine the system or equipment to
- 10 be reexamined at the time and in the manner directed by the
- 11 secretary of state except that:
- 12 (1) the reexamination must occur at an open meeting
- 13 <u>subject to Chapter 551, Government Code; and</u>
- 14 (2) an audiovisual recording of the reexamination must
- 15 be created and made available to the public on request.
- (c) Subchapter B, Chapter 2001, Government Code, applies to
- 17 all proposed reexaminations and certification decisions made as a
- 18 result of those examinations by the secretary of state under this
- 19 subchapter.
- 20 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
