1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to agreements with public junior colleges for courses for  
1-9 joint high school and junior college credit.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Section 130.008, Education Code, is amended by  
1-12 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

1-13 (d) A public junior college may enter into an agreement with  
1-14 a school district, organization, or other person that operates a  
1-15 high school to offer a course as provided by this section regardless  
1-16 of whether the high school is located within the service area of the  
1-17 junior college district.

1-18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-22 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
