## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to a notification requirement if a counselor is not assigned to a public school campus. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 33, Education Code, is 5 amended by adding Section 33.009 to read as follows: 6 7 Sec. 33.009. PARENTAL NOTIFICATION CONCERNING SCHOOL COUNSELORS. (a) A public school, including an open-enrollment 8 9 charter school, that does not have a full-time school counselor certified under Subchapter B, Chapter 21, assigned to the campus 10 for more than 30 consecutive instructional days during the same 11 school year shall provide written notice of the absence of a 12 counselor to the parent of or other person standing in parental 13 14 relation to each student enrolled in the school. (b) The principal of the school shall provide the notice 15 16 required by Subsection (a) not later than the 30th instructional day after the first day the school does not have a full-time school 17 counselor assigned to the campus. 18 19 (c) The school shall: (1) make a good faith effort to ensure that the notice 20 required by this section is provided in a bilingual form to any 21 parent or other person standing in parental relation whose primary 22 23 language is not English; and 24 (2) retain a copy of any notice provided under this

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1 section.

2 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2009-2010 3 school year.

4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
