(a) The attorney general shall immediately pay into the state treasury money received for a debt or penalty. 10 11 (b) The comptroller shall credit to the judicial fund for 12 programs approved by the supreme court that provide basic civil legal services to the indigent a civil penalty that is recovered in 13 14 an action by the attorney general in any matter that is actionable under the Deceptive Trade Practice Act except when the terms of the 15 16 judgment require that the payment be made to another named recipient. a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
