- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 801.256(b), Occupations Code, is amended 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (b) An applicant is eligible for a special license if:
- 8 (1) the applicant:
- 9 (A) is at least 21 years of age and a graduate of
- 10 a board-approved veterinary medicine program at an institution of
- 11 higher education; or
- 12 (B) provides to the board a written affirmation
- 13 by a person described under Subsection (f) that the applicant meets
- 14 a critical need for staffing at the person's institution and is
- 15 certified by a nationally recognized veterinary specialty board or
- 16 is eligible for that certification; [and] or
- 17 <u>(C)</u> is a graduate of an American Veterinary
- 18 Medical Association-listed school or college of veterinary
- 19 medicine and is employed in a post-Doctor of Veterinary Medicine
- 20 training program at an American Veterinary Medical Association
- 21 accredited school or college of veterinary medicine; and
- 22 (2) the applicant passes the jurisprudence section of
- 23 the licensing examination.
- 24 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
