A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the regulation and enforcement of dam safety by the 3 Texas Commission on Environmental Quality; providing civil and 4 administrative penalties.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6 SECTION 1. Sections 11.0842(a) and (b), Water Code, are

7 amended to read as follows:

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(a) If a person violates this chapter, a rule or order 8 9 adopted under this chapter, Section 12.052, or Section 16.236, or a permit, certified filing, or certificate of adjudication issued 10 under this chapter, the commission may assess an administrative 11 penalty against that person as provided by this section. The 12 commission may assess an administrative penalty for a violation 13 relating to a water division or a river basin or segment of a river 14 basin regardless of whether a watermaster has been appointed for 15 16 the water division or river basin or segment of the river basin.

17 (b) The penalty may be in an amount not to exceed \$5,000 for each day the person is in violation of this chapter, <u>a</u> [the] rule or 18 order adopted under this chapter, or a [the] permit, certified 19 filing, or certificate of adjudication issued under this chapter. 20 21 The penalty may be in an amount not to exceed \$10,000 for each day the person is in violation of a rule or order adopted under Section 22 23 12.052. The penalty may be in an amount not to exceed \$1,000 for each day the person is in violation of a [the] rule or order adopted 24

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1 under Section 16.236 [of this code]. Each day a violation continues
2 may be considered a separate violation for purposes of penalty
3 assessment.

4 SECTION 2. Section 12.052, Water Code, is amended by 5 amending Subsections (a), (c), and (e) and adding Subsections (g) 6 and (h) to read as follows:

(a) The commission shall make and enforce rules and orders
and shall perform all other acts necessary to provide for the safe
construction, maintenance, <u>operation</u>, repair, and removal of dams
located in this state. <u>In determining the frequency that dams</u>
<u>located in this state are inspected</u>, the commission shall give
<u>preference to inspecting dams that are classified as posing a high</u>
<u>or significant hazard as defined by commission rule</u>.

14 (c) If the owner of a dam that is required to be constructed, 15 reconstructed, maintained, operated, repaired, or removed in order to comply with the rules and orders promulgated under [Subsection 16 17 (a) of] this section wilfully fails or refuses to comply within the 30-day period following the date of the commission's final, 18 19 nonappealable order to do so or if a person wilfully fails to comply with any rule or other order issued by the commission under this 20 section within the 30-day period following the effective date of 21 the order, the person [he] is liable for [to] a penalty of not more 22 than <u>\$10,000</u> [\$5,000] a day for each day <u>the person</u> [he] continues 23 24 to violate this section. The state may recover the penalty by suit brought for that purpose in the district court of Travis County. 25

(e) If the commission issues an emergency order underauthority of this section without notice to the dam owner, the

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1 commission shall fix a time and place for a hearing which shall be held as soon as practicable to affirm, modify, or set aside the 2 3 emergency order. The notice does not have to comply with Chapter 2001, Government Code. If the nature of the commission's action 4 5 requires further proceedings, those proceedings shall be conducted appropriate under Chapter 2001, Government Code 6 as [the 7 Administrative Procedure and Texas Register Act, as amended 8 (Article 6252-13a, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes)].

9 (g) The commission may assess an administrative penalty as 10 provided by Section 11.0842 against a person who violates a rule or 11 order adopted under this section.

12 (h) This section does not affect the right of any private 13 corporation, individual, or political subdivision that has a 14 justiciable interest in pursuing any available common law remedy to 15 enforce a right or to prevent or seek redress or compensation for 16 the violation of a right or otherwise redress an injury.

SECTION 3. (a) The changes in law made by this Act to Sections 11.0842 and 12.052, Water Code, apply only to a violation that occurs on or after the effective date of this Act. For purposes of this section, a violation occurs before the effective date of this Act if any element of the violation occurs before that date.

(b) A violation that occurs before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date of the violation, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

27 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

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a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
