H.B. No. 2560

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1
2 relating to delinquent payment of an alcoholic beverage retailer's
3 account for liquor.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 102.32, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
6 amended by adding Subsection (d-1) to read as follows:

7 (d-1) The commission or administrator may not accept the
8 voluntary cancellation or suspension of a permit or allow a permit
9 to be renewed or transferred if the permit holder is delinquent in
10 the payment of an account for liquor under this section. A person
11 whose permit is canceled by the commission or whose permit has
12 expired is not eligible to hold any other permit or license under
13 this code until the person has cured any delinquency of the person
14 under this section.

15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
19 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
