- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 3.007(d), Family Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (d) A spouse who is a participant in an employer-provided
- 8 stock option plan or an employer-provided restricted stock plan has
- 9 a separate property interest in the options or restricted stock
- 10 granted to the spouse under the plan as follows:
- 11 (1) if the option or stock was granted to the spouse
- 12 before marriage but required continued employment during marriage
- 13 before the grant could be exercised or the restriction removed, the
- 14 spouse's separate property interest is equal to the fraction of the
- 15 option or restricted stock in which:
- 16 (A) the numerator is the period from the date the
- 17 option or stock was granted until the date of marriage and, if the
- 18 option or stock also required continued employment following the
- 19 date of dissolution of the marriage before the grant could be
- 20 exercised or the restriction removed, the period from the date of
- 21 dissolution of the marriage until the date the grant could be
- 22 exercised or the restriction removed; and
- 23 (B) the denominator is the period from the date
- 24 the option or stock was granted until the date the grant could be

- 1 exercised or the restriction removed; and
- 2 (2) if the option or stock was granted to the spouse
- 3 during the marriage but required continued employment following the
- 4 date of dissolution of the [after] marriage before the grant could
- 5 be exercised or the restriction removed, the spouse's separate
- 6 property interest is equal to the fraction of the option or
- 7 restricted stock in which:
- 8 (A) the numerator is the period from the date of
- 9 dissolution [or termination] of the marriage until the date the
- 10 grant could be exercised or the restriction removed; and
- 11 <u>(B)</u> the denominator is the period from the date
- 12 the option or stock was granted until the date the grant could be
- 13 exercised or the restriction removed.
- SECTION 2. Sections 3.007(a), (b), and (f), Family Code,
- 15 are repealed.
- 16 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies to a
- 17 suit for dissolution of a marriage pending before a trial court on
- 18 or filed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 19 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
