- 1 automobile insurance policy may provide for payment of benefits

- 4 by the policy, even in the absence of an assignment of benefits.
- 5 SECTION 5. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 6 an insurance policy delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed on
- 7 or after January 1, 2010. An insurance policy delivered, issued for
- 8 delivery, or renewed before January 1, 2010, is governed by the law
- 9 in effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and
- 10 that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 11 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
