## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 508, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 508.193 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 508.193. SEARCHES. A parole panel shall require as a
- 8 condition of parole or mandatory supervision that, at the request
- 9 of a parole officer and regardless of whether the officer has a
- 10 warrant authorizing the search, a releasee allow the requesting
- 11 officer to search the releasee's person, vehicle, or residence,
- 12 including the curtilage of the residence, for the purpose of
- 13 <u>supervising the releasee's compliance with conditions of parole or</u>
- 14 mandatory supervision that prohibit the releasee from possessing
- 15 certain specified materials, objects, or substances.
- SECTION 2. Section 11, Article 42.12, Code of Criminal
- 17 Procedure, is amended by adding Subsection (j) to read as follows:
- 18 (j) If a judge grants community supervision to a defendant
- 19 convicted of a felony, the judge shall require as a condition of
- 20 community supervision that, at the request of a supervision officer
- 21 and regardless of whether the officer has a warrant authorizing the
- 22 <u>search</u>, the defendant allow the requesting officer to search the
- 23 defendant's person, vehicle, or residence, including the curtilage
- 24 of the residence, for the purpose of supervising the defendant's

- 1 compliance with conditions of community supervision that prohibit
- 2 the defendant from possessing certain specified materials,
- 3 <u>objects</u>, or substances.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
