## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the powers of a recreational district board in a county

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

- 5 SECTION 1. Section 324.099, Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsections (1) and (m) to read as follows:
- 7 (1) The managing entity, as defined by Section 221.002,
- 8 Property Code, of a timeshare property, as defined by Section
- 9 221.002, Property Code, shall collect and remit to a district, on a
- 10 property owner's behalf, all district taxes imposed under
- 11 Subsection (b)(2) if the managing entity participates in the rental
- 12 of the property by either:
- 13 (1) advertising rental availability on behalf of the
- 14 property owner; or
- 15 (2) collecting the rent on the property owner's
- 16 behalf.

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- 17 (m) If a managing entity located in the district does not
- 18 collect rent or advertise rental availability on behalf of its
- 19 property owners, a certificate executed in good faith by the
- 20 managing entity and delivered to the district informing the
- 21 district that the managing entity does not collect rent or
- 22 advertise rentals on the behalf of property owners shall be final
- 23 and binding on the district, so long as the certificate remains
- 24 accurate.

- 1 SECTION 2. Subchapter E, Chapter 324, Local Government
- 2 Code, is amended by adding Section 324.0995 to read as follows:
- 3 <u>Sec. 324.0995. TAX EXEMPTIONS. (a) Section 324.099(b)(2)</u>
- 4 does not impose a tax on:
- 5 (1) an employee of the United States government
- 6 conducting official business in the district; or
- 7 (2) a person who occupies a lodging facility or
- 8 campground in the district if the person has evacuated from the
- 9 person's home due to an emergency and the state has temporarily
- 10 suspended collection of the state hotel occupancy tax.
- 11 (b) The district may not tax a transaction between a person
- 12 and an interest operated by:
- 13 (1) the United States in the district; or
- 14 (2) a state park in the district.
- 15 SECTION 3. Section 324.122, Local Government Code, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 324.122. EFFECT OF INCORPORATION OR ANNEXATION. The
- 18 incorporation of a political subdivision or the annexation of any
- 19 part of [any area in] a park district by a political subdivision
- 20 does not affect the district's boundaries.
- 21 SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act does not
- 22 affect tax liability accruing before the effective date of this
- 23 Act. That liability continues in effect as if this Act had not been
- 24 enacted, and the former law is continued in effect for the
- 25 collection of taxes due and for civil and criminal enforcement of
- 26 the liability for those taxes.
- 27 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
