5 SECTION 1. Section 30.05(a), Penal Code, is amended to read

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

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- 7 (a) A person commits an offense if $\underline{\text{the person}}$ [he] enters or
- 8 remains on or in property of another, including residential land,
- 9 agricultural land, a recreational vehicle park, a building, or an

- 12 consent] and the person [he]:

- 14 (2) received notice to depart but failed to do so.
- SECTION 2. Section 30.05(b), Penal Code, is amended by

- 17 (8) "Protected freshwater area" has the meaning
- 18 assigned by Section 90.001, Parks and Wildlife Code.
- 19 (9) "Recreational vehicle park" means a tract of land

- 23 by a dwelling and zoned for or otherwise authorized for
